

Camp Policies

1. Campers are to respect staff and other campers.
2. Campers should wear modest and casual clothes. Shoes are to be worn at all times.
3. ALL Campers are expected to participate in ALL planned activities.
4. Once at Camp, campers may not leave the grounds without the Director or Dean's permission.

What to Bring
